- **Total Available Budget:** €2100 for all applications.

What is an STSM?

A Short-Term Scientific Mission (STSM) funds a **visit to a host institution in another country** for a specific scientific task aligned with the objectives of the COST Action. It supports collaboration, data collection, training, and knowledge exchange.

- **Duration:** 5 to 90 days (up to 180 days in exceptional cases)
- **Maximum grant amount:** €2100
- **Eligible applicants:** Researchers or innovators affiliated to a legal entity in a COST Full or Cooperating Member, a Near Neighbour Country, or a European RTD Organisation
- **Reimbursement:** After submission and approval of the final scientific report

Eligibility & Guidelines

- The applicant must be a registered participant in the COST Action **CA23145 – CitySenZ**.
- The mission must take place in a different country than the applicant's home institution.
- The proposed work should clearly contribute to the advancement of the scientific goals of **CitySenZ**, particularly in relation to architectural and urban ambiances.
